## FINALS POLICY

---

### RugbyWA Final Playoff's

KDRUC recognizes the efforts of players, coaches and supporters of all teams that reach their respective semi or grand final play offs.

People like winners and the Club wants to encourage and reward winners – whether junior or senior teams.

This Policy defines what the Club is prepared to do and to provide consistency for all teams and age groups.

Any changes to this Policy must be vetted by the Junior President and Director of Rugby, prior to being presented to the Committee for approval.

### Who qualifies?

- Junior teams who qualify for semi or grand final play offs Under 11 to Under 18 age groups.
- Senior grade teams who qualify for semi or grand final play offs.

### What we will do

#### Semi Finals – All age Groups

- Provide a team meal at the Club Thursday evening prior to their respective semi-final games; to a maximum value of \$10 per team player, coach and manager.
- Provide 1 drink (soft, beer, wine or cider) dependent on age.

#### Grand Finals – Juniors

- Provide a team meal at the Club Thursday evening prior to their respective semi-final games; to a maximum value of \$10 per team player, coach and manager.
- Provide 1 drink (soft, beer, wine or cider) dependent on age.

#### On game day:

- Provide 1 bottle of Powerade per player.
- Provide half-time refreshments such as oranges, bananas and/or bag of snakes / lollies.
- Each player to be given a copy of the RugbyWA official winning team's photograph at the junior presentations and 1 print to be retained by the Club for its records.
- Winning Grand finalist teams can purchase their playing jerseys from the Club at replacement cost



## Grand Finals - Seniors

- Provide a team meal at the Club Thursday evening prior to their respective semi-final games; to a maximum value of \$10 per team player, coach and manager.
- Provide 1 drink (soft, beer, wine or cider) dependent on age.

### On game day:

- Provide 1 Coach to and from the venue of the finals per qualifying team.

Note:

- a) coaches organised for supporters are to be at supporters' cost.
  - b) It is the responsibility of team management to ensure that the coaches leave and arrive on schedule. Any additional fees chargeable for coaches due to late departures are to be at the teams /supporter's costs.
- Provide 1 bottle of Powerade per player
  - Provide half-time refreshments such as oranges, bananas and/or bag of snakes / lollies.
  - Provide 1 team carton per team for enjoyment on the coach returning to the Club and 1 team carton on arrival at the Club.
  - Provide a team meal to a maximum value of \$400 for the participating players and team officials.
  - Each player to be given a copy of the RugbyWA official winning team's photograph at the senior awards presentations and 1 print to be retained by the Club for its records.
  - Winning Grand finalist teams can purchase their playing jerseys from the Club at replacement cost

## RugbyWA 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Premiership Division Grand Final

The Fortescue 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Premiership Division is the pinnacle of Club Rugby in Western Australia and winning the Premiership division provides significant benefits to the Club and requires additional recognition.

On achieving the 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Premiership Division Grade Final, the Committee will consider any additional recommendations made by the Director of Rugby and / or 1<sup>st</sup> Grade coach to those noted in this policy.

Requests are to be costed and submitted to the Committee for consideration prior to the semi-finals to allow enough time to action.

On winning a 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Premiership Grand Final; KDRUC will also:

### On The day:

- Provide the 1<sup>st</sup> Grade players and team management with a meal to a maximum value of \$600
- Provide the 1<sup>st</sup> Grade players and team management drinks throughout the evening (observing the responsible service of alcohol for these members).
- Provide a taxi service to 1<sup>st</sup> Grade players and team management at the end of the evening if requested.



### **Afterwards:**

- Embroider the Year and Premiers below the Club's logo on the 1<sup>st</sup> Grade playing shirts.
- Frame a Premiership Jersey signed by the winning playing squad along with an official RugbyWA photograph of the Premiers.
- Each player to be given a copy of the RugbyWA official winning team's photograph at the Senior award presentations. Along with their embroidered Premiership playing Jersey.

### **Other Competitions**

Teams representing the Club in RA approved competitions -either home or abroad - (i.e. Spring 7's or Bali 10's)

The Club (via the Director of Rugby) will consider any reasonable request submitted by the participating teams – prior to the commencement of the competition.

This is to ensure appropriate budgeting and fiscal responsibility.

Retrospective requests will generally not be considered.

### **Recognition and Awards**

- Any Flags, Pennants Cups, Shields or other "team awards" made to the team in recognition of the teams successes; by teams representing Kalamunda Districts Rugby Union Club; belong to the Club and must be presented to the Club at the earliest possible time after completion of the award presentations.
- Any individual medals presented to the players and team officials belong to the players and team officials and may be retained by them.

### **Notes:**

This policy can be reviewed and amended by the Club Committee at any time without prior notice.

In special situations, the Club's Director of Rugby can recommend alternative recognitions to the Committee for approval.
