



REFEREE ABUSE

PLEASE NOTE that in light of continuing referee abuse occurring, WARURA is developing detailed policy and procedures for managing referee abuse. In the Interim, they have informed all referees to follow the following protocols effective immediately:

Any person involved in Referee Abuse will be issued a **RED CARD** at the time of the abuse regardless of that person being a player, coach, team manager or spectator.

The issuing of the Red Card can be done before, during or any time after the match. A **Red Card** will also be issued if the abuse is directed at an AR'S (including club appointed).

Any person being issued a RED CARD for Referee Abuse will be required to attend a judiciary hearing and will be incumbent on KDRUC to ensure attendance at such a hearing.

WARURA has also reserved their rights to apply further sanctions upon a team and/or Club involved, including withdrawing provision of match day services.

KDRUC DOES NOT CONDONE REFEREE ABUSE AND ASKS ALL MEMBERS TO TAKE NOTE.
